Because our definition of success is so much more than grades and test scores!





- It's the time when we decide how we want to see ourselves, how we want others to see us
- It's the time when we find the passions that follow us into adulthood!



our 4 core beliefs

- **RELATIONSHIPS ARE PRIMARY.** We don't learn from people we don't like! Our teaching methods and schedule are built on this belief.
- Punishment is not a Good Teacher. Behavior can be a developmental delay like math or reading. It needs to be taught, not punished!
- LITERACY OPENS DOORS. Each class is built on a foundation of reading, writing, and speaking. We use culturally relevant pedagogy to make our classes come to life and promote equity.
- **KIDS Need Voice And Choice!** Our kids take art, play in the band, travel to debate tournaments, and rock climb (among many other things). HG exists to help you find what you love to do and to give you the opportunity to do it!



HUMANITIES

A mix of English and Social Studies. Our study of history is focused on social justice and centers Black, Indigenous, and People of Color.

MATH

Our focus is building your conceptual understanding of mathematics rather than having you memorize rules.

Each unit of study starts with a mystery that by the end of the unit, you must solve through scientific research, observation, and investigation.

VOICE AND CHOICE: EXPLORING YOUR OTHER CLASSES




SCHOOL DAY CLUBS


DUAL LANGUAGE

If you were enrolled in a dual language program in elementary, continue your studies in Spanish at Hamilton Grange




